PRAIRIE COUNTY PREDATOR CONTROL BOARD BY LAWS

- 1. THE P.C.P.C.B. was established on November 27, 2002. The Board was established to assist the wildlife services with predator control.
- 2. Anyone who owns or works with livestock can be a board member. Appointments are made following nomination by an existing board member. Members shall serve three-year terms, and may be reappointed if so nominated. The terms of the membership seats shall be staggered, and two of the six membership seats shall become vacant each year.
- 3. The board consists of seven individuals, six of whom are members: 1 Ex Officio, 1 Chairman, 4 members, and 1 non-member secretary. The officer positions of Ex Officio and Chairman shall be appointed by the board, as shall the appointment of the non-member secretary.
- 4. The board reviews and sends the requested PAC money for sheep and cattle to the wildlife services in Billings, MT. The PAC money pays for the use of helicopters, airplanes, and the government trapper. The board also supports Prairie County 4-H and the annual Prairie County Sportsman Association Annual Coyote Calling Contest.
- 5. The board shall meet at least once annually, along with special meetings as may be prudent. Said meetings shall be open to the public.

6. Decisions of the board shall be made by a majority vote of the members present at a duly held meeting. No business may be conducted without the presence of a quorum of the board, with a quorum being defined as a majority of the board members.
