Less than 1% of Prairie County voters took advantage of the early in-person option to pick up their ballot that was available from October 2nd through noon on October 9th.

The ballots for active, registered voters were officially taken to the post office on Friday, October 9th and will be arriving in your mailbox soon, if they have not already!

What does this mean to you?

You still have time to register to vote and receive a ballot for the Federal General 2020 Election! October 26th is the end of voter registration with late registration beginning on October 27th. During late registration, all requests must be made in-person with identification presented at 217 W Park Str., Terry.

Ballots can be tracked from the time they were mailed until they are received and verified in the Election Administrator's office at www.myvoterpagemt.com.

Ballots can be voted from the privacy of your own home or if you would like, you can bring your ballot to the courthouse and vote your ballot in the designated voting booths. We also have the ExpressVote available for all voters.

Once your ballot has been voted, place the ballot into the yellow secrecy envelope. Enclose the yellow secrecy envelope in the postage-paid affirmation envelope that has been signed by you and return in-person or by mail. *Make sure this is received in our office by Tuesday, November 3rd at 8:00 PM.

If you have not received your ballot by October 19th or if you need to replace your ballot for any reason, please contact the Election Administrator's office at (406) 635-5575.
