

Election Connection Vol 9

Election Day is less than two weeks away! Time is quickly passing; we are here to make sure that you have everything you need to vote and let your voice be heard!

- ★ If you have NOT received your ballot or need to have yours replaced for any reason; please come to the Election Administrator's office with your identification to have a new ballot issued.
- ★ Extra copies of the Voter Information Pamphlets (VIP) are available in our office. The VIP lists each initiative and has arguments for and against each. (One was mailed on September 30th to each household with a registered voter)
- ★ Ballots can be voted in the privacy of your home, at the polling booth in the Prairie County Courthouse, or by using the ExpressVote in the Election Administrator's office. The courthouse is fully opened, we do ask that the Governor's Directives be followed.
- ★ Once you have voted your ballot and sealed it in the yellow secrecy envelope, enclose it in the white and blue affirmation envelope and sign the back of that envelope.
- ★ Ballots can be returned at the Prairie County Courthouse in the Election Administrator's office, at the Fallon Coffeeshop during select dates/times (listed below) or mailed. **Remember:** If you mail your ballot the return postage has been paid for you. Also, when mailing your ballot, please allow enough time for your ballot to be received by our office. All ballots must be received in our office by 8:00 PM on Election Day, November 3rd, regardless of the postmark.
- ★ [Montana Ballot Interference Prevention Act \(BIPA\)](#) was repealed; therefore, you do not need to complete a form when returning a ballot for another person.
