Prairie County Board of Commissioners Christine Keltner and Dennis Teske met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. Commissioner Todd Devlin is attending the Western Interstate Region (WIR). In attendance Administrative Assistant Harry McNall.

9:00 a.m. Pledge of Allegiance, public comment. John Pisk with DES joined the meeting to speak with the commissioners about the Senior Center Generator. John gave the commissioners a timeline and a breakdown of expenditures for the work done.

9:15 a.m. Road Supervisor Todd Henry joined the meeting. He updated the commissioners on current road projects, including how many miles of road need graded/graveled etc.

10:15 a.m. Commissioner Teske read the minutes from May 14th, 2025, commissioners meeting.

10:20 a.m. Commissioner Teske made a motion to accept the minutes from May 14th, 2025, commissioners meeting as corrected, seconded by Commissioner Keltner, "all in favor" motion passed.

10:30 a.m. David Seitz and Jamie Larson with Seitz Insurance for Workers Compensation Review. David went over in detail the Renewal Proposal for Prairie County. The Montana State Fund Insurance is the most economical.

10:55 a.m. Commissioner Teske made a motion to renewal the "Montana Association of Counties (MACo) Workers Compensation Group Plan Enrollment for renewal", seconded by Commissioner Keltner "all in favor" motion passed.

11:05 a.m. Public Health Nurse Tylene Eaton updated the commissioners about the immunization action plan grant and Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHELP) Grant.

11:12 a.m. Commissioner Teske made a motion to accept and sign the "Master Contract HHS-PHSD-00000627 Task Order Number 26-07-4-31-136-0 Immunization Program" seconded by Commissioner Keltner, "all in favor" motion passed.

11:24 a.m. Commissioner Keltner made a motion to accept and sign "Task Order 26-07-6-11-044-0 for Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) Grant Application" seconded by Commissioner Teske "all in favor" motion passed.

11:40 a.m. County Treasurer Garrett Lapp updated the commissioners about County Investment Report, personal property tax was increased and mobile home property tax decreased. He then updated the commissioner on the cash reconciliation report, which is now at a positive \$166.42 and has been since March 2025. At the end of May, it will be considered revenue, and the

balance will set to "\$0" and the balance moved into a revenue line and will make the county balanced for the first time since 2018.

Commissioner Keltner and Teske signed the Treasurer Investment Report.
